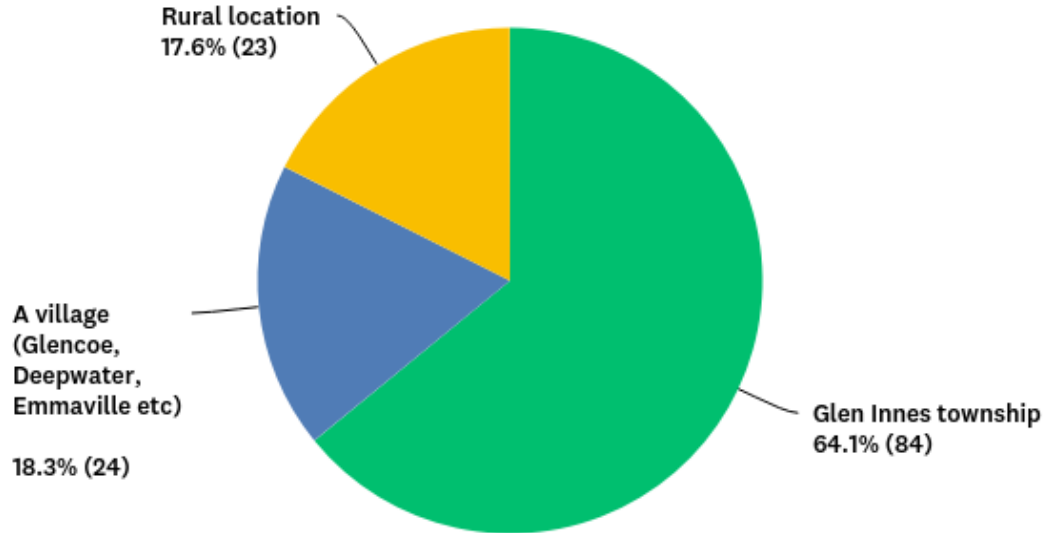

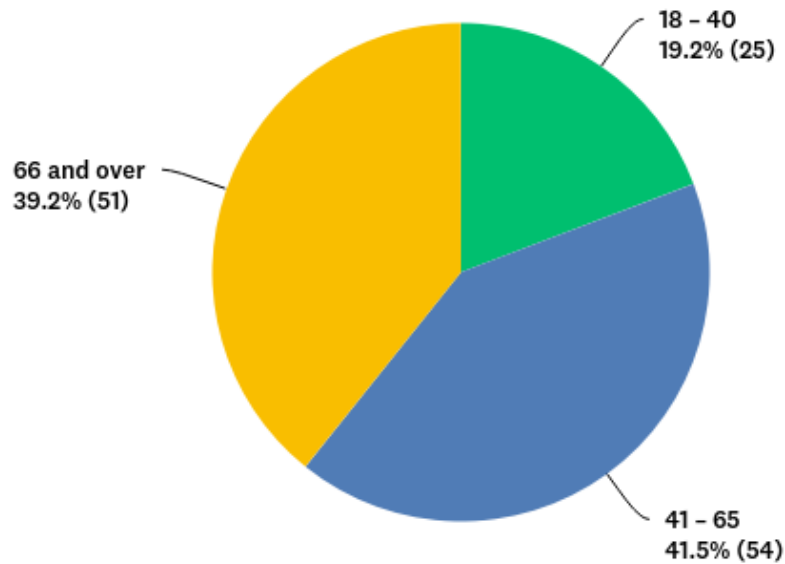
Q1: Where do you live?

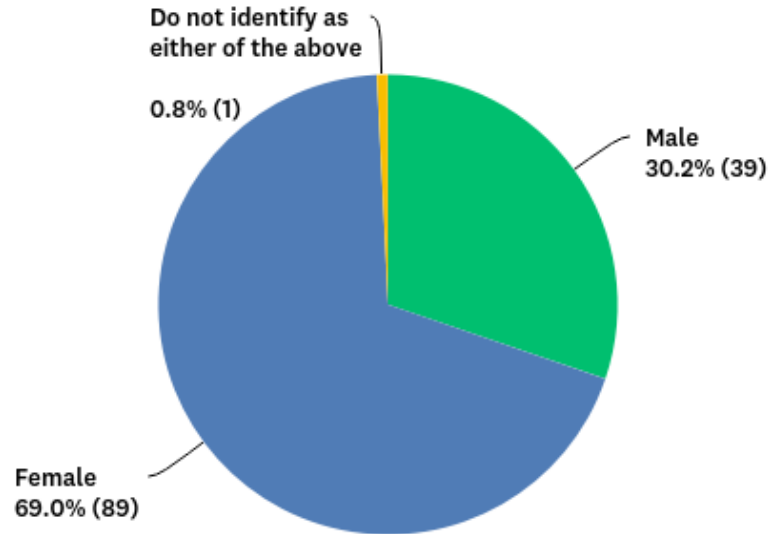
Q2: How old are you?

Answered: 130 Skipped: 1



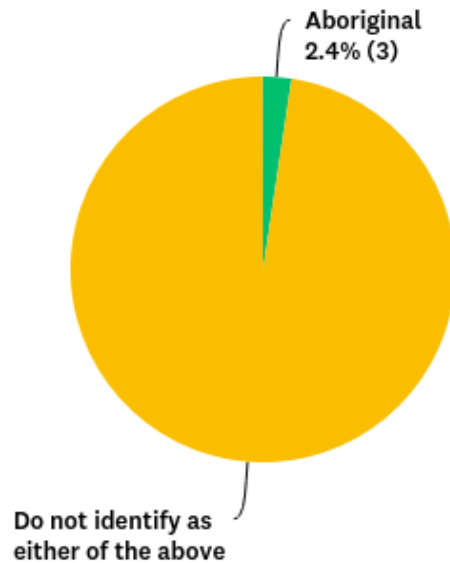
Q3: What gender are you?

Answered: 129 Skipped: 2



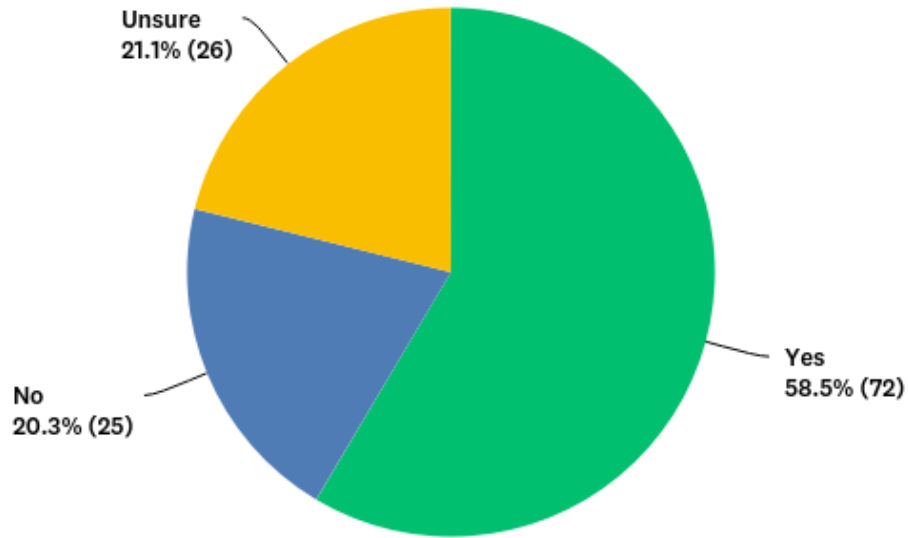
Q4: Are you Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander?

Answered: 126 Skipped: 5



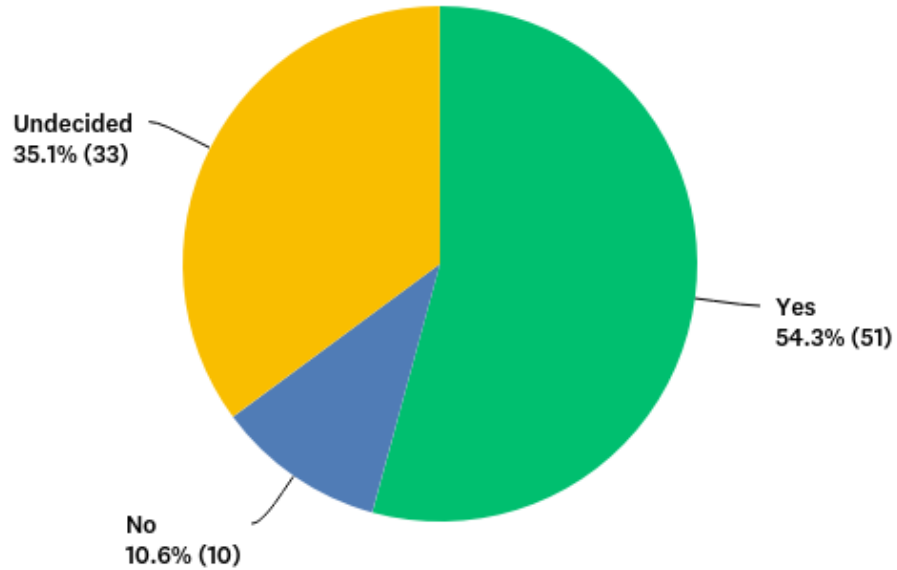
Q5: Would you qualify for one of these loans based on the stated criteria above?

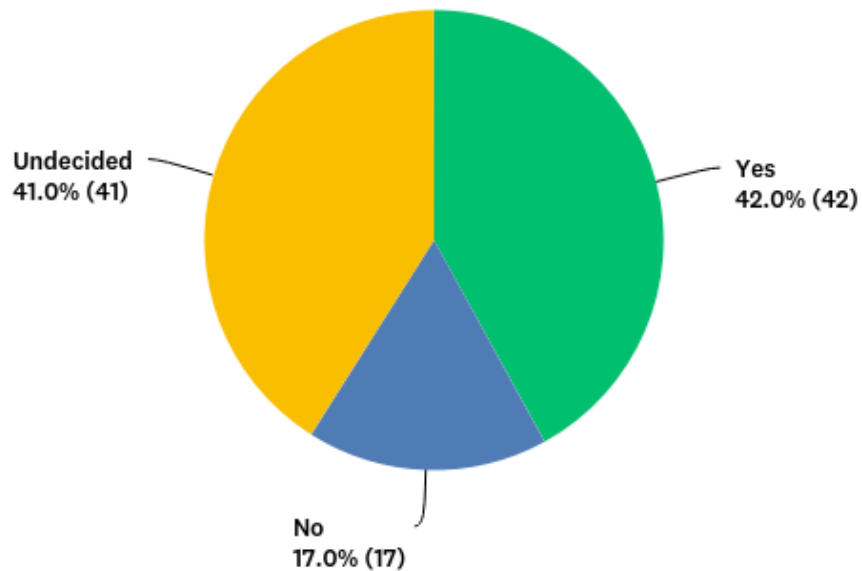
Q6: If Yes, then would you be interested in taking up one of these loans?

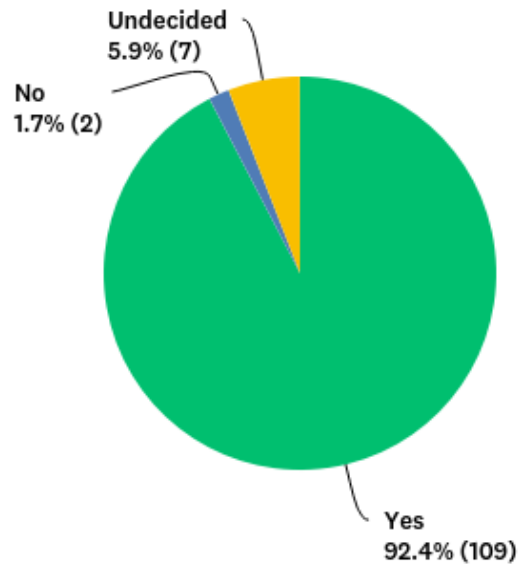
Q7: Would you be interested in an alternative program developed through the local community?

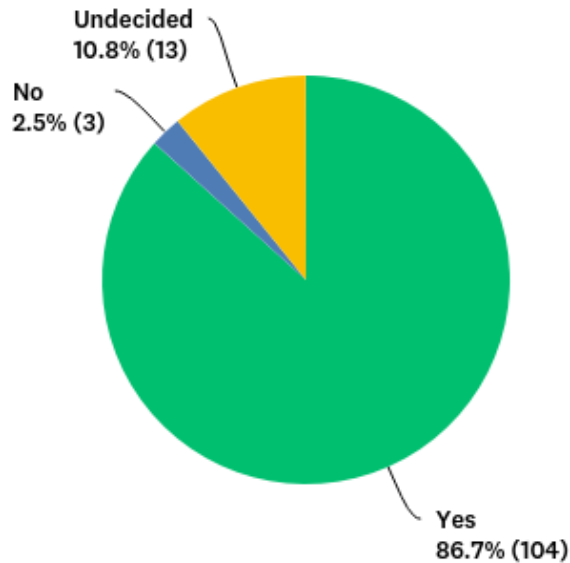
Q8: Would you support community efforts to help reduce the cost of electricity by increasing the take up of renewables?

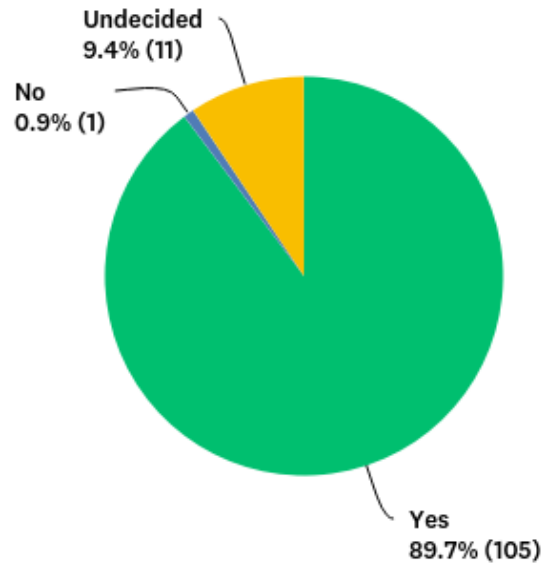
Q9: Would you support the development of a Community Owned Renewable Energy project in the Glen Innes Severn Shire area?

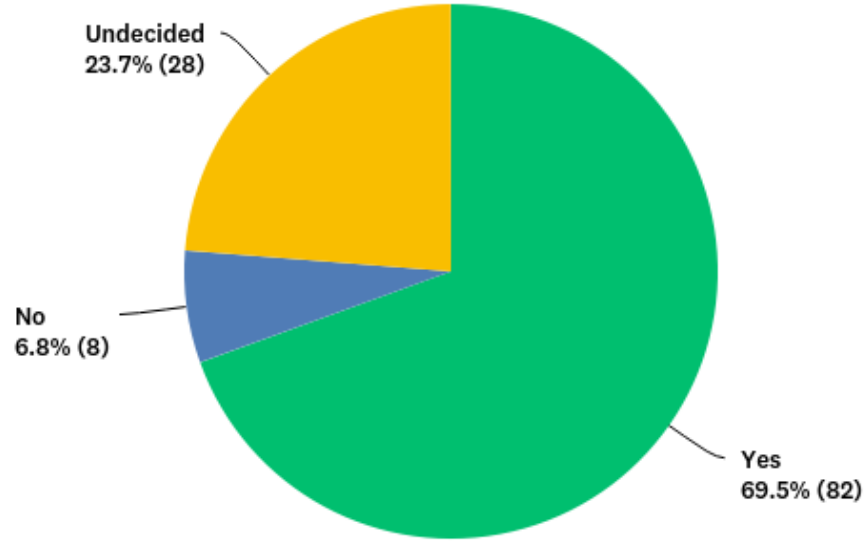
Q10: Do you think that the local council should be increasing its use of renewable energy to source its power needs?
