In preparation to transition from the *Horticulture Marketing and Research and Development Services Act 2000* to the new legislative framework, Hort Innovation welcomes the opportunity to discuss administrative arrangements for the new levies' legislation with DAFF in 2024, acknowledging it is subject to the Parliamentary process.
