I am a casual employee, working as a Madigan Real Estate, currently earning around commission per hour.

I am a mother of two now adult children. When my children were small they looked forward to spending the weekend together. If I had to work the extra money was used to pay for holidays/ treats like special outings like the zoo/ events.
