
Structure

Industry Snapshot – September 2018

APSAA members currently represent 96,522 student accommodation beds throughout the Asia-Pacific with a projected growth of a further 22,385 beds in the pipeline across Australia.



APSAA Membership Snapshot - September 2018

APSAA currently represents 71 member organisations with locations in all Australian states and territories, across New Zealand, in Malaysia as well as Singapore. That's 90% of ALL student accommodation beds in Asia-Pacific. Our Institute and Corporate membership covers all staffworkingins tudent accommodation across three areas; Management, Operations and Finance, Student Experience and Wellbeing, Facilities and Development.

Currently, significant growth is occurring in Melbourne. There is 12,012 beds in the pipeline to 2023 – with an existing 21,204 beds that amounts to a 56.6% growth from 2018-2023.* (JLL 2018)

These operators employ hundreds of professional student services personnel ensuring students are well catered for in all areas of health and wellbeing, providing support services and pastoral care and live-in experiences that are worldsbest practices.
