We do not mind the Naplan Testing. What we don't agree with is the publication of the results outside of that particular school environment. We do not think the comparison of results is valuable in the education process. All that this encourages is for students to be practised to complete the test successfully or to an accepted percentage. There are far too many variables between schools to fairly compare. The Naplan data should only be used by the school itself to further improve their results in a confidential situation.
