At this morning's Inquiry into the Water Legislation Amendment (Inspector-General of Water Compliance and Other Measures) Act 2021, Senator McCarthy asked the Nature Conservation Council to provide evidence of water bird decline in the Murray Darling Basin, and the link to the loss of wetlands.

Please find links to the Eastern Australian Waterbird Aerial Survey that has been undertaken every year since 1983 by Professor Richard Kingsford from the University NSW Centre for Ecosystem Science.
