I have a donor father and would one day hope to meet him, or at least have that as a possibility. I do not want any laws preventing me, or my twin sister, from doing this. I feel it is only fair that we have the chance to meet/contact our biological father and that he, in turn, has the opportunity to meet/contact us if that is what he wishes to do. It would be helpful and wonderful to have access to information about whether we have half-siblings out there. Not having this knowledge could lead to situation in the future that are better avoided, e.g. falling in love with an unknown relative.
