Recently a "Visa Capping Bill" introduced to parliament. As an 885 skilled independent applicant I've been patiently wait for one and a half years already.

During the 18 months time,

- DEC 2009, I bought a restaurant business and the property of it together in Newtown cost \$850,000. (......). I am the head chef and the boss of my restaurant now. This business contains 50 seats and 8 staffs.
- Two months ago my wife and I also purchased our future home in Sydney's North shore area cost \$910,000.
- We've also have our investment property in Ryde area now worth \$500,000 on the market.

The reason that we did all the things above is because this is we feel our permanent residency is secured: the government, the immigration office, the migration agents all told us nothing is going to be happened to the people who already applied their PR.

As a dependent applicant --- my wife (ju Shen) is a graduate architect at the moment. She completed both Bachelor and Master degree of architecture in University Technology Sydney last year. She got a job before her graduation in a local architecture firm (House Plan By Design)

- My wife has already work in her company for nearly 1 year
- After we told her boss about the "visa capping bill" she wants to get the sponsorship for us because my wife is acting an important role in her company now.

The situation is:

- As a business owner I may obtain State/Territory government sponsorship
- My wife may obtain sponsorship from her company

The problem is:

- We are holding bridging visa, we cannot change the application type onshore.
- If cooks are no longer needed, Architect is still on the new SOL list, if I will be capped, how about my wife? Just because I was the main applicant and she will be capped together because of me?
- We came here 10 years ago, We have a business, 3 properties, 2 cars, 8 staffs our past was here, our life is here and our future is here too, if the new rule gonna cap us, how can we just get everything done and pack up within 28days?

Thanks very much for your time, I can provide all the receipts and references according to the points that I mentioned above, please understand our situation, personally I think send people back by judging on their visa application type is a not sensible decision.....
