Dear Mervyn,

Here is my response:

The allegation that I was involved in an attempt to portray a false story about the origin of SARS-CoV-2 is demonstrably false and malicious. There is abundant documentary evidence to show that I and my colleagues initially had concerns about a possible laboratory origin of SARS-CoV-2, immediately shared the relevant information with appropriate government agencies, consulted with other experts in field, and eventually dismissed those concerns as unfounded, writing a peer-reviewed scientific paper on the subject. This paper even concludes “More scientific data could swing the balance of evidence to favor one hypothesis over another”.

Like many people globally, I first heard about what became COVID-19 when information on the disease became public on December 31st 2019. I have only very limited academic association with the EcoHealth Alliance and the Wuhan Institute of Virology.
