Question: Is that [the decision to suspend processing for individuals from Sri Lanka and

Afghanistan] a proposal which came from the department?

Answer: The suspension of processing of asylum claims for individuals from Sri Lanka and

Afghanistan was a result of an iterative process of policy development based on discussions between the department and the government. This resulted in the

announcement by Minister Evans on 9 April 2010 to immediately suspend processing of new asylum claims from Sri Lankan and Afghan nationals, for a period of three months and six months respectively, while country information and related guidelines for

refugee status determination were reviewed.
