




Regional Communities eligible for consideration under the Public Governance, Performance and Accountability (Location of Corporate Commonwealth Entities) Order 2016

Notes:

* Regional communities eligible to be considered under the policy order to meet the following policy order requirements:

- that a corporate Commonwealth entity with agricultural policy or regulatory responsibilities is to be located:
 - a) In a regional community; and
 - b) Within 10 kilometres by road of the main campus of a regional university that is recognised for research and teaching in the field of agricultural science.

Regional communities means a community that is not within 150 kilometres by road of Canberra or a capital city of a State.

^ Marcus Oldham College is an agricultural college that is not listed on the Universities Australia website.

Buffer distances are 'strait line' distances, not 'by road' distances, therefore distances are indicative only.

Charles Sturt University falls outside the 'Capital city' buffer but falls within the 'Greater Capital City' buffer.
