Senator Lines, Sue (L&CA) written:

Can the Department provide a copy of the latest reports provided by operating Immigration Detention Centres (IDC) covered by this Bill that provides details of the training and accreditations of Immigration Detention Services Provider (IDSP) personnel (as noted in the Explanatory Memorandum (EM))?

Answer:

As at Q1 2015 there are 7,046 training courses and qualification required to be current for all sites across the Immigration Detention Network, with 90% overall confirmed compliance. This number is impacted by the CPR training requirement, as CPR is a new contractual requirement, which came into effect December 2014. Excluding CPR overall compliance with training and qualifications for all sites across the Immigration Detention Network is 96%. It should be noted that compliance rates may also include staff that have completed initial induction but are yet to commence detainee facing roles.
