



WA organisations contribute to inquiry into governance in the Indian Ocean Territories

The Joint Standing Committee of National Capital and External Territories will hear from Perth-based individuals and organisations as part of its inquiry into governance in the Indian Ocean Territories.

Committee Chair, Mr Luke Simpkins MP said, “recent hearings on Cocos (Keeling) and Christmas Islands reveal that residents have a range of views about their governance arrangements, and various ideas for economic development into the future. Some of these issues are ones that have been raised in previous inquiries, some are newer ones. The Committee intends to assess the situation in 2015, and to discuss ways to move forward.”
