Inquiry into the Multi-User Barge Ramp Facility - East Arm, Darwin, Northern Territory

The Public Works Committee is conducting an inquiry into the proposed multi-user barge ramp facility at East Arm in Darwin.

The Department of Defence told the Committee that the facility has been designed in partnership with the Land Development Council in the Northern Territory.

The proposed barge facility will provide Defence watercraft round-the-clock capability to load and unload helicopter docks, other amphibious ships and explosive ordnance irrespective of tidal conditions in Darwin.

The facility will be also made available to commercial users and will leverage the Land Development Council's investment in local property development, road access and other infrastructure at East Arm.

The estimated cost of the barge facility is \$18.0 million, with Defence contributing \$16.1 million to the project.

The Committee's Chair, Senator Dean Smith, said the Committee will conduct public and incamera hearings for the inquiry in Darwin in late April 2015.
