Everything was going fine until now. There is no value of this qualification in my country. I feel like I have been ripped off thousands of dollars on the pretext of getting good future after finishing the studies and could get a permanent residency. now when I have done whatever suggested by the immigration minister and spent \$40,000 to \$50,000 on my study and living here and now I have be informed that I might not get permanent residency because Australian government d doesn't need us this means that they have smuggled me to Australia to make money and when we have spend that money and expecting a better future here, they are planning to through us out of the country. Instead of deciding on these bill kindly ask a question to the minister of immigration whether he was sleeping at the time of granting student visas or accepting files for permanent Residency.

You can raise the bar for people or put hold on accepting file.
