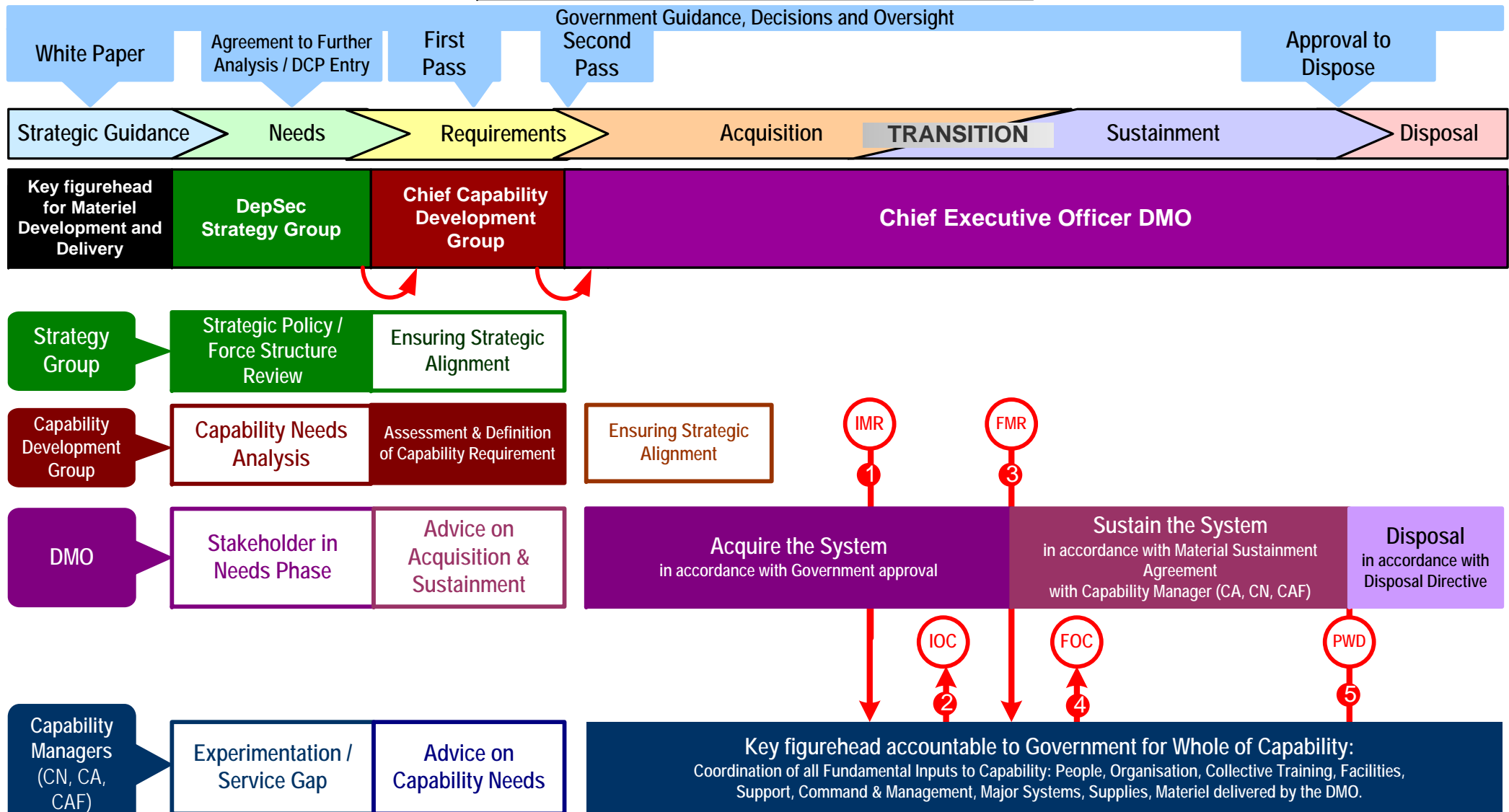

- 1 **Initial Materiel Release** marks the completion and release of DMO acquisition project supplies required to support the achievement of Initial Operational Capability.
- 2 **Initial Operational Capability (IOC)** is the capability state relating to the in-service realisation of the first subset of a capability system that can be employed operationally. IOC is endorsed at second pass project approval, and its achievement is reported by the Capability Manager.
- 3 **Final Materiel Release** marks the completion and release of DMO Acquisition Project Supplies required to support the achievement of the Final Operational Capability.

- 4 **Final Operational Capability (FOC)** is the capability state relating to the in-service realisation of the final subset of a capability system that can be employed operationally. FOC is endorsed at second pass project approval and its achievement is reported by the Capability Manager.
- 5 **Planned Withdrawal Date** is the high-level plan for the timeframe that an asset will be removed from service, based on current funding agreed to by Government.
