RE: TREATY BETWEEN AUST.&  
REPUBLIC OF KOREA. CLASSIFIED  
MILITARY INFORMATION.

DEAR SIRs.

IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THE EXECUTIVE THAT THIS TREATY NOT BE RATIFIED AT THIS TIME FOR SECURITY REASONS. WE ARE NOT OPPOSED TO THIS TREATY, HOWEVER AS TENSIONS BETWEEN NORTH AND SOUTH KOREA ESCALATE, WE BELIEVE THAT ANY MILITARY INFORMATION SHOULD BE WITH HELD . THE EXECUTIVE FEARS THAT THE PRESENT MILITARY TENSIONS IN THE REGION COULD RESULT IN A WAR SITUATION FOR THE PACIFIC AREA .AS HISTORY AS SHOWN IN THE LAST KOREAN CONFLICT WE WERE NOT PREPARED AS WE COULD HAVE BEEN ,WE THE EXECUTIVE CALL ON THE PARLIAMENT TO BRING OUR TROOPS FROM THE MIDDLE EAST .OUR FORWARD BASES SHOULD BE INCREASED AND TROOP NUMBERS INCREASED AS A PROTECTION OF AUSTRALIA. THE EXECUTIVE DO BELIEVE THAT AN ASIAN WAR WILL RESULT FROM THESE TENSIONS. WE CALL ON THE PARLIAMENT TO PREPARE FOR MILITARY ACTION AS A RESULT OF THE TENSIONS IN ASIA. WE THE EXECUTIVE FULLY SUPPORT THE PEOPLE OF SOUTH KOREA, AND SUPPORT CO OPERATION WITH THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH KOREA. THE EXECUTIVE WISH TO THANK THE COMMITTEE FOR ALLOWING US TO COMMENT ON THIS SERIOUS MATTER .
