Inquiry into Multiculturalism in Australia

I am opposed to the encouragement of multiculturalism in Australia particularly because it encourages and supports Muslims.

Islam is diametrically opposed to civilisation as we know it. Islam has embraced slavery and encouraged terrorism since its foundation.

Its founder, the polygamous Abdul Cassim (also known as Muhammad) if alive today would be reviled and convicted as a paedophile in Australia for his sexual relations with his nine year old wife, Ayesha Bint Abu Bakr. She is only one of his eleven known wives. Islam allows the degrading and deplorable abuse of women and has a frivolous view of marriage.

Winston Churchill wrote 'But the Mahommedan (sic) religion increases, rather than lessens, the fury of intolerance'. 'Jihad' (Holy War) was so important to Muhammad that he declared it the second most important deed in Islam and the sixth pillar of Islam. In consequence serious critics of Islam are invariably opposed by life threatening violence and destruction of property with the ultimate objective of establishing 'Dar-Es-Salem' (House of Peace) as found in Saudi Arabia, Libya and Yemen. Islam has initiated wars since its foundation. Charles Martel is remembered for winning the Battle of Tours in 732, in which he defeated an invading Muslim army and halted northward Islamic expansion in western Europe. Others at the time were not so fortunate. In the first century of Islam, three thousand two hundred churches were destroyed or converted into mosques. The Christian Crusades in the eleventh century were a reaction to centuries of Islamic Jihad. The fifteenth century saw the destruction of Constantinople by Islam invaders with the murder of Christians within the greatest Christian church in the world at that time Hagia Sophia. After this the tide turned with the Muslims invaders being driven out of Spain. In the sixteenth century, the overt threat to central Europe was ended by victories at the naval battle of Lepanto and the land battle at the gates of Vienna. Massacres by Muslims occurred in the nineteenth century in many countries including Lebanon and Bulgaria. The twentieth century saw widespread massacres of Armenian and Maronite Christians. In the twenty first century we have witnessed the destruction of the World Trade Center by Muslim terrorists.

William Muir (1819-1905), a distinguished Orientalist, concluded 'the sword of Muhammad and the Quran are the most fatal enemies of civilisation, liberty and truth which the world has yet known'.
