



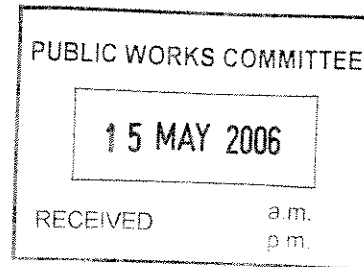

I write in reference to the Public Works Inquiry into the Australian Institute of Police Management (AIPM) Redevelopment at North Head, Manly, New South Wales as per the notice in the Sydney Morning Herald weekend edition April 22-23, 2006.

Senior Police from across Australia, overseas jurisdictions and South Australia (SAPOL) have been involved for many years with the AIPM executive leadership and management courses, both as students and lecturers. The attendees have undergone an intensive development programme at the Institute, which we deem critical in managing major incidents, investigations into terrorism, people smuggling, fraud, child exploitation and drug trafficking.


