TL off-line for most of Term 4 2009 (although borrowing could continue for about 6 weeks of the term) and Term 1 2010 to attend BER meetings, liaise with builders, sub-contractors, site managers, project managers, suppliers, staff, students and parents. As well, with parent support (and after having done risk assessments), we had to pack up the library (into over 600 boxes), move everything into another building so that the old library could be used for another purpose. Then we had to move everything into the new library and store it there until the new furniture arrived (and it's still coming!). Fortunately, I had asked classroom teachers to let me know what they thought they'd need for the first few weeks at the beginning of the school year, and we packed those resources into carefully marked boxes and stored them where they could be found in January. Now that most of the furniture is in place and the shelves have been re-stocked, it seems that all the new carpet tiles (which are lifting) will have to be taken up and reglued, so here we go again. The ordering process has been a nightmare. Our Business Services Manager won't have anything to do with the P21 aspect of BER because she isn't placing orders. So I've had to obtain all the quotes, send them to the project manager who then places the order with Education Queensland Facilities people. There have been many, many mistakes, cases of companies not being paid for up to 3 months, wrong furniture being delivered (and not sorted out yet). As well, the accounts kept by us, our program manager and Education Queensland people aren't matching. I was told 'there is \$9 000 left for furniture, fittings and equipment, but don't send any more orders because it might be only \$7 500'. Now it seems that there's just over \$2 500 left ... and could I please work out what the real answer is!!!!!! (I'm working on it.) Since May last year, I've been getting very little sleep, and working long hours and weekends. I know this is a job creation project, but it has been a 'work creation' project for me.</p> <p>Having said all that, our new building is fantastic and this time next year I'll have forgotten all the angst. And honestly, I'm fortunate that I've been heavily involved (and I asked to be), unlike some of my colleagues who have had nothing to do with the project. One said, "My principal is doing everything. There has been no floor space left vacant for reading groups. On a positive note they will supply me with 3 new return boxes (not that I need that many).
