**Information in relation to TRA referrals: Provided by Sue Hunt, Quality Assurance Consultant, Office of Tasmanian Qualifications Authority**

One of the functions of the Overseas Qualifications Units is to provide information and referral service to overseas qualified tradespersons.

Over the past three years there have been very few cases referred to TRA from the Overseas Qualifications Unit.

Tradespeople referred to TRA and who have then undertaken further assessment at TAFE are

Electrical Mechanic – Bosnia

Electrician – Germany

Electrical Installer – The Sudan

Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Mechanic – Peru

Electrician – South Africa X 2 (received ARTC certification then referred to licensing body)

Plumbers – South Africa X 2

Several other tradespeople have been referred to TRA (Melbourne office) and anecdotal evidence is that they gained an Australian Recognised Trade Certificate.

\*\*\*In relation to reference that TRA have been given extra funding to assist with mutual recognition of licensing arrangements...this should have been **resourced** rather than **resourced** and is more to do with off-shore assessment than mutual recognition of licensing arrangements.
