- Development of canine kennelling and training facilities for the Australian Federal Police at Majura, ACT. The estimated cost is \$10.2 million; and
- Fit-out of new leased premises for the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations at Brindabella Business Park, ACT. The estimated cost is \$15.5 million.
