Males are arguably the backbone of industry in this country and we will ensure that if the laws aren't changed without dispute they will be changed with dispute.

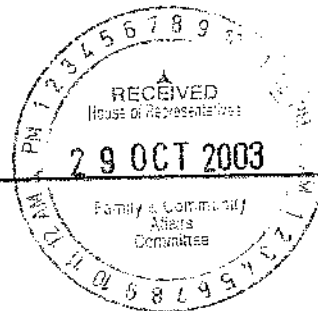
