CONSERVATION OF MIGRATORY
SPECIES OF WILD ANIMALS.

DEAR SIRS.

IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THE AUSTRALIAN PATRIOT MOVEMENT
NATIONAL EXECUTIVE THAT THIS TREATY BE RATIFIED.

PROTECTION OF ALL ENDANGERED SPECIES IS A POLICY OF THIS
EXECUTIVE. WE HAVE ASKED IN THE PAST FOR THE SETTING UP OF A
NATIONAL COAST GUARD, IT IS HIGHLIGHTED BY THIS TREATY.

THERE IS NO POINT HAVING A TREATY IN PLACE TO PROTECT OUR
MARINE LIFE, IF THERE IS NO ENFORCEMENT IN PLACE.

THE AUSTRALIAN NAVY CANNOT BE EXPECTED TO ENFORCE SUCH A
TREATY, AND PROTECT AUSTRALIA AT THE SAME TIME. THERE IS MANY
ABLE BODIED UNEMPLOYED PEOPLE WHO CAN BE TRAINED TO FORM A
NATIONAL COAST GUARD. NOT ONLY THESE PEOPLE WOULD HELP IN THE
PROTECTION AGAINST ARMS SMUGGLING, BOAT PEOPLE, DRUGS BEING
SMUGGLED INTO THE COUNTRY, AND ILLEGAL FISHING. ONCE AGAIN WE
CALL FOR AN AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL COAST GUARD TO BE FORMED.


