This girl was released from the Wilston Correction Institution into the care of a PROCTOR for three months. It was at this time that our paths crossed.

After three months the department set her up in a flat on her own in Albion.

At a later occasion I asked the proctor (a thirty year old, unemployed (formerly) lady) how the girl was.

I was horrified to learn that the girl was in hospital, had been there for five days

as she had been brutally raped by a group of young lads from the ~~Wilton~~ ~~Det~~ Correction Institution.

The next comment rocked me:-

"She will now be brothel bait"!

What happened to the young fourteen year old at the John Orley Centre indicates to me that we are not looking at two isolated events but something much more evil existing within government departments.

Thankfully many of the former policemen, Police Commissioners, Parliamentarians, have deceased for these people were part of the rotteness.

There is a saying that our talents will fade away but three things shall remain

faith:

We need to have faith in our institutions - political, legal caring, family, church

hope

When all of the above come crashing down that the goodness of those listed above can be rebuilt

love

This has been denied by people who go about their work who brutalize the innocent

Some officials treat the public in an abhorrent way.

I pray that Almighty God will inspire you and help you to see that the innocent people receive all that is their due.

For our society to halt this down hill slide,
where people are deemed to be worthless objects
we must cry out that no matter how long
away ago these young people were crushed/
abused/raped we will give them :-

hope and above all
love.
