Dear Secretary

I refer to your Committee's inquiry into the Immigration Bridge project.

I wish to register my strong opposition to this scheme. I do so on two basic grounds.

First, a structure of this kind should not be erected over Lake Busley Giffin. It is inconsistent with the design philosophy of the lake. It would interfere with established usage of the lake, such as rowing and sailing. And it is very ugly.

Second, a lake facility should not be commercially exploited. Despite the "non-profit" status, the proponent is selling a product, and will retain some of the proceeds if the project terminates.
