## Re: Radio Industry Inquiry - Submission


I refer to your letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2000 concerning the abovementioned matter in which you had invited submissions to the inquiry by the closing date of 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2000.

This matter was considered by the Council, at its meeting on the 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2000 when it was resolved that a submission be made in respect to diminished radio reception in the Oberon Council area.

While Oberon appears to be serviced well by a considerable array of local and regional radio stations, it has been noted that the signal strength being received from radio transmission sites appears to be diminishing and some radio stations which previously could be received without too much difficulty, are now being lost in terms of reception.

It is difficult to know what the reason is for this but it certainly needs to be investigated and the matter is submitted to your inquiry for appropriate action.
