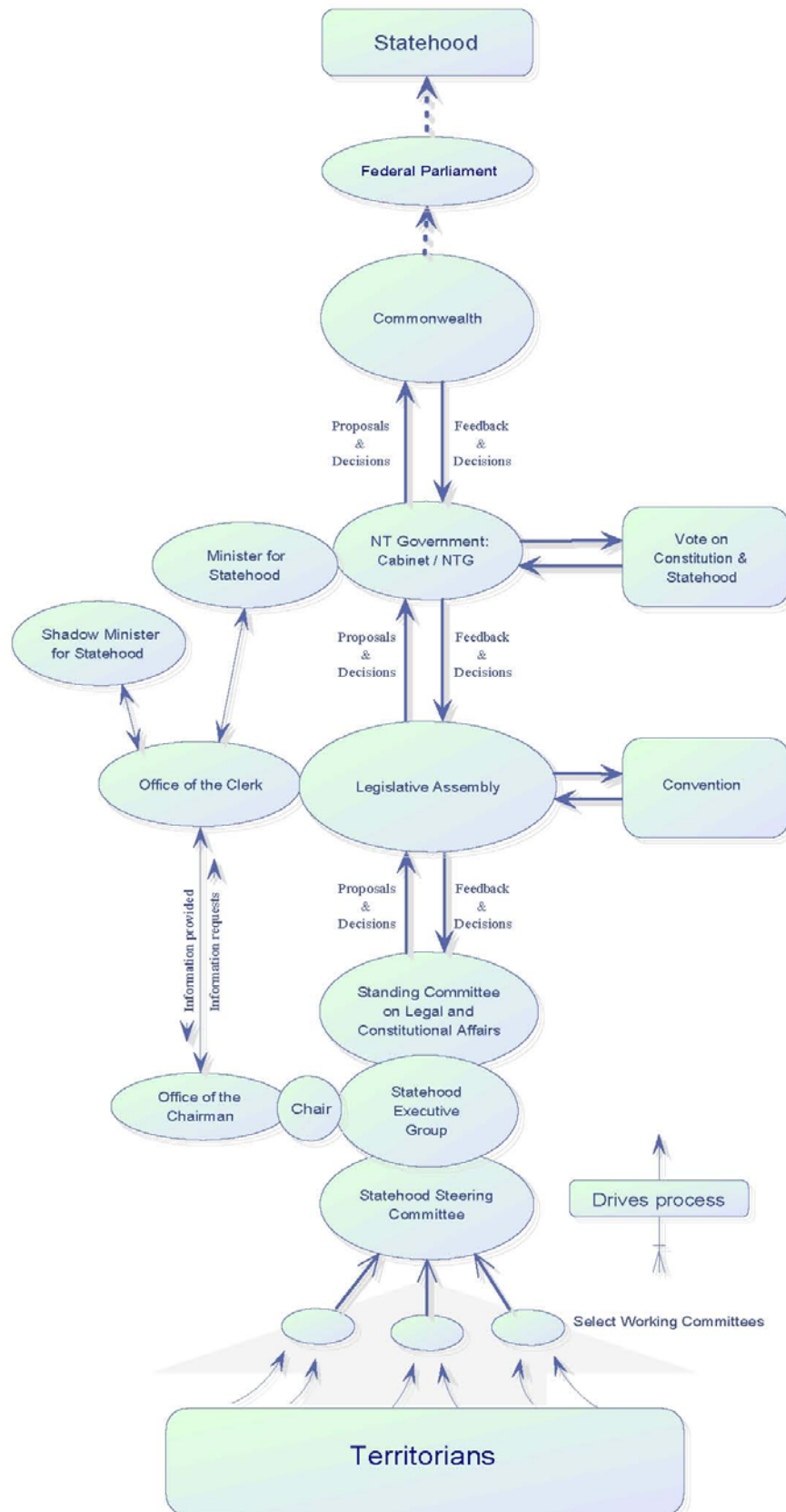

Statehood entities & relationships — November 2006



Roles and responsibilities :

Federal Parliament:

- Votes on Bill/s

Commonwealth:

- Feedback, advice, decisions on —
- Constitutional parameters,
- Policy positions, and
- Presents legislation to Federal Parliament.

NTG:

- Responds to SSC,
- Formulates policy, and
- Makes representations to Commonwealth.

Minister & Shadow:

- Sponsor Statehood process; and
- Bipartisan approach.

Legislative Assembly:

- Debates, votes on and ratifies legislative instruments.

Office of the Clerk:

- Acts as bureau for Minister & Shadow.
- Information requested by Minister, Shadow to be reported to Statehood Executive Group.

Legal and Constitutional Affairs:

- Liaises with and reports to Legislative Assembly on Statehood process, and
- Provides oversight, parameters.

Statehood Executive Group:

- Board of management for Office of Chairman, and
- Coordinate & liaise between SSC & LCAC.

Office of the Chairman, provides:

- Research,
- Discussion papers,
- Advice and information, and
- Education / engagement.

Statehood Steering Committee:

- Engages Community through:
- Consultation, and.
- Education
- Provides recommendations.

Territorians:

- Grass-roots inputs to Statehood process,
- Vote in referenda.
