



Report on marriage equality bills to be tabled on Monday

The Marriage Equality Amendment Bill 2012 and the Marriage Amendment Bill 2012 both seek to allow same-sex marriages in Australia and to recognise same-sex marriages conducted overseas.

The House of Representatives Social Policy and Legal Affairs Committee inquired into the two bills, and will table its report in Parliament at approximately 10.40am on Monday 18 June.
