Sir,

Laura is situated in Cape York, and is in receipt of one Radio Broadcast - ABC FM - which is transmitted locally.

Our problem is that the Broadcast comes from LONGREACH, and not from the local station at CAIRNS.


As this is our only Radio, it is very important during the Cyclone Season for weather reports, but at present is totally useless as we receive Western Queensland Weather, from LONGREACH.

When this station commenced we received CAIRNS, but for some reason we were transferred to LONGREACH. Cooktown to the east of us, and Coen & Wiepa to the north all enjoy CAIRNS broadcasts

We would be grateful if we could be transferred back to CAIRNS ABC _ FM, before the onset of the Wet Season.
