As a resident of regional Australia I would like to inform the House Communications Committee of my difficulty in receiving 4 of the 10 FM stations available in Hobart. The quality of reception of ABC Classic FM, in particular, fluctuates according to weather conditions. The commencement of broadcasting of TJJ, about a decade ago, made the reception of THE FM, a community radio station, even worse.

I am particularly disappointed that Radio National is still broadcast in Hobart in AM not FM. The resulting inferior reception detracts from the enjoyment of music broadcast especially.

The local 936 ABC radio provides a good service of local news, sport, community service announcements and cultural activities.

I would support any measures which improves the quantity and quality of radio services in regional Australia.
