



## Economics Committee to Discuss Tourism Rogue Operators at Hearing in Melbourne

The issue of rogue operators in tourism industry will be on the agenda at a House Economics Committee hearing in Melbourne tomorrow. The committee will hear from the Australian Tourism Export Council and the Department of Industry, Tourism and Resources.

The public hearing will form part of the committee's inquiry into the service exports sector. The inquiry, which was referred by Treasurer Peter Costello, is looking at Australia's potential economic strengths beyond the resources boom.
