

DEAR SIRs.

IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THE EXECUTIVE THAT THIS TREATY BE  
RATIFIED.

IT IS OUR POLICY TO SUPPORT TRADE AND INVESTMENT PROTECTIONS  
WITH OTHER NATIONS, COSTS TO THE AUSTRALIAN PEOPLE ARE ALWAYS  
OF CONCERN TO THE EXECUTIVE . IT SEEMS THAT WITH ALL TREATIES  
THAT IT IS ALWAYS AUSTRALIA WHO PAYS , NOT THE OTHER NATION  
INVOLVED . IT IS OUR POLICY THAT THIS ONE SIDED DEAL IS IN THE  
INTERESTS OF AUSTRALIA , AS SUCH A FUTURE PATRIOT GOVERNMENT  
WOULD REVIEW THIS AGREEMENT. IF A NATION DID NOT AGREE TO OUR  
POLICY , THEN THE TREATY WOULD BE TERMINATED . AS THE EXECUTIVE  
IS NOT INVOLVED IN THIS FIELD , WE CAN NOT ADD ANY MORE TO THIS  
SUBMISSION , WE DO THANK THE COMMITTEE FOR ALLOWING US TO  
COMMENT ON THIS TREATY.
