Darwin, Alice Springs and Yulara visits for vocational education and training in schools inquiry

The rapidly growing area of vocational education and training (VET) in schools is being investigated by the House of Representatives Education and Training Committee. The inquiry is examining the range, structure, resourcing and delivery of vocational education and training programs in schools, including teacher training, the impact of vocational education on other programs, vocational education in new industries, and the accessibility and effectiveness of vocational education for Indigenous students.

The Committee has visited NSW and Queensland and will now spend a week in the Northern Territory.

The Territory visit will commence on **Monday** afternoon with a hearing in **Darwin** at Parliament House with the NT Government and the Northern Territory Chamber of Commerce. On **Tuesday** the Committee will visit Taminmin High School in **Humpty Doo** to talk to students, teachers and work placement coordinators about vocational education programs in schools. On **Wednesday**, school visits will continue in **Alice Springs**, followed by a hearing on **Thursday** morning at the Alice Springs Town Council rooms with Tangentyere Council and representatives from the Alice Springs Workplace Learning Community. On **Friday** the Committee will visit Nyangatjatjara College at **Yulara**.
