Further to my appearance before the Joint Standing Committee on Electoral Matters on Tuesday 8th of October, I provide further information which may be of assistance to the Committee's deliberations.

- Observation 1: There is no analysis of the assisted voting by the AEC which it is accepted can reach 90% in aboriginal communities.
- Observation 2: The AEC has made no analysis of the significant voting change from 1998 results to 2001 results, which I enclose. The 2001 result is more consistent with previous elections.

Election 1998	-	ALP 981	Liberal 247	Informal 1.4%	80%/20% 2PP
Election 2001	-	ALP 828	Liberal 403	Informal 3.0%	67%/33% 2PP

- Observation 3: The AEC has made no comment on the necessity for Remote Mobile Booth 5, which is part of Port Augusta where the Grey AEC Office is located, and has the strongest pre-poll facility in the electorate.

I also enclose all declaration vote results for the 2001 election.

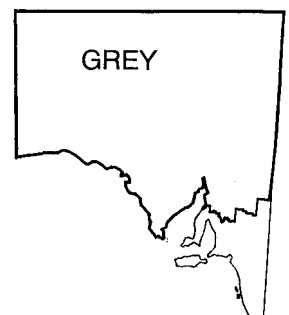
