Please see below the response on behalf of The Director of the State Library of South Australia.

- a) SLSA support the online availability of documents tabled in Parliament. Consideration needs to be given to legal deposit legislation; would hardcopy production be disbanded? Any reliance on born digital as masters would require a robust sustainable digital preservation system.
- b) Short-term and long-term access to PPS (as for most born digital government documents) is essential.
- c) Technological barriers will be met but can be overcome. The National Library of Australia's TROVE http://trove.nla.gov.au/ site provides national and international access to content; this could be a model to explore. Australian and NZ State and Territory libraries peak body National and State Libraries Australasia support a collaborative model in the supply of information and could provide comment http://www.nsla.org.au/
- d) There are now a number of models for trusted digital repositories and distribution. Current literature worth reviewing is attached.
- e) In considering a model for administration, there is option to encourage the State and Territory government publications units to work within the same model thereby providing Australians with standardly arranged, ready access to all government publications.
