RE: INQUIRY INTO REGIONAL RADIO SERVICES


Our reception on all radio stations is extremely poor. We find it increasingly difficult to obtain a decent radio signal in Apollo Bay.

In an attempt to alleviate this problem we purchased a High Performance Extended Range Receiver radio, only to find the reception is still unsatisfactory.

The radio communication medium has brought great enjoyment to us over many years. However, since moving to Apollo Bay we have been continually frustrated by the poor quality radio reception. Frequently the signals are so inadequate there is no alternative but to turn the radio off. We feel that in this aspect our quality of life has been diminished by these shortcomings.
