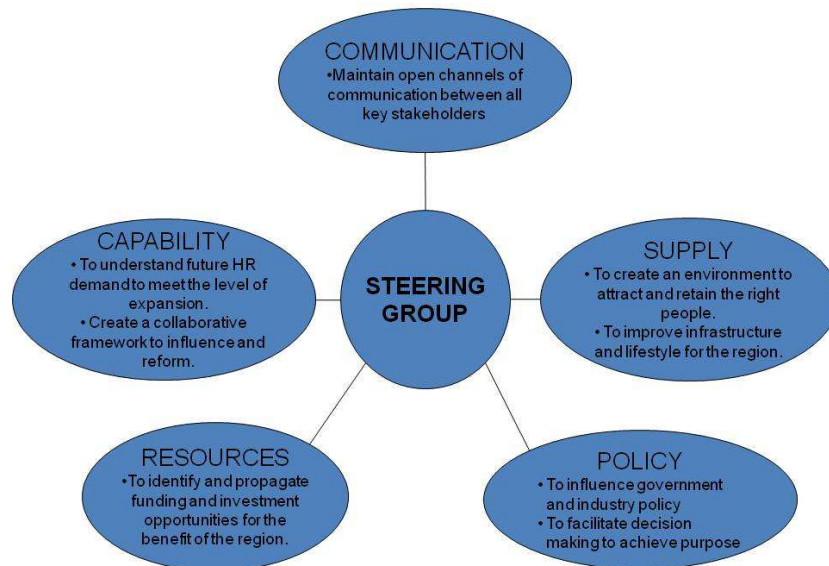


### The Action Platforms
