Question

Mr HAWKE: What about cost orders? Do you get cost orders a lot? Mr Mullaly: We do. We seek cost orders in pretty much every matter that we take on a civil basis. Whether or not we can recover them will depend on the defendant.

CHAIR: Can you take on notice what those cost orders are over the last several years and what your recovery is.

Mr Mullaly: Sure. We have that information.

Answer

In the financial years 2018-19 to 2023-24 (to 31 March 2024), ASIC recovered a total of \$61,691,149 in investigation and litigation costs in relation to 112 matters. This total is comprised of:

- \$20,928,601 in investigation costs, paid by 70 defendants, and
- \$40,762,548 in litigation costs, paid by 123 defendants.
