Update to SQ20-000024 relating to approved child care

Question

Referring to SQ20-000024, please update table 1 and table 2 with the latest data and estimates over the forward estimates period.

Answer

Table 1 presents the **number of children and families** estimated to be using approved child care over the period 2020–21 to 2023–24, as at Budget 2020–21.

Please note: the Child Care Forward Estimates Model was redesigned at MYEFO 2016–17. Since MYEFO 2016–17, the difference in the number of children and families largely reflects the impact of compliance measures in Family Day Care.
