Senator RICE: Is there a policy limit on how far back you're pursuing debts?

Ms Lees: My understanding is that there's no policy limit on how far back debts are pursued. Senator RICE: That's in contrast with ATO debt, for example, where there is a time limit.

So, you could be pursuing debts that people had a decade ago?

Ms Lees: That's my understanding.

Senator RICE: My last question is whether you could provide on notice the number of debts you're pursuing by location, amount, when the debt was incurred and any different categories of evidence that you have underpinning the claim.

Ms Lees: I'll take that on notice.
