# SE21-300 - Update of AE21-458 - No: of transitory persons in Australia

Senator Nick McKim asked:

What is the number of transitory persons in Australia (Update of AE21-458):

- a. In immigration detention (total);
- b. In immigration detention centres; and
- c. In Alternative Places of Detention.

Answer:

As at 31 August 2021, there were 1179 tranistory persons in Australia.

Of these, 619 were in immigration detention, including:

- 83 in held detention facilities;
  - o 39 in immigration detention centres / immigration transit accommodation
  - o 44 in alternative places of detention (APOD).
