The new strategy and procurement process will be largely complete by the expected time of tabling of the ANAO Report, on this basis there would be little scope to apply any changes to that process. However, the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) would review the ANAO Report and if any recommendations were made, would seek to apply changes to future procurements. AMSA has well established and robust processes for reviewing any audit findings, assigning responsibility, developing actions and evaluating impacts of actions prior to closing findings.
