The Senate has passed a Bill for "An Act relating to a proposed Agreement between the Commonwealth, the Australian National Airlines Commission and certain Companies in connexion with Airline Services, and to amend the 'Civil Aviation Agreement Act 1952'", and transmits the same to the House of Representatives for its concurrence.
