 - (b) The estimated expenditure on Federal Old-age Pensions.
 - (c) The estimated expenditure on services already approved by the Commonwealth Parliament or Government, including new Defence Scheme, payments under Bounties Bill, Immigration, and Northern Territory.

Question—put and resolved in the affirmative.

3. Customs Tariff Bill (1907).—The Order of the Day having been read for the further consideration in Committee of the whole House of the Senate's Message No. 28 in regard to this Bill, Mr. Speaker left the Chair, and the House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole.
