During our JSCOT public hearing on the Singapore Australia Free Trade Agreement amendments on 20 June, Mr Turnbull asked if there was any 30 per cent requirement for graduates from United Kingdom universities to enter Singapore. The Department took this question on notice. We have since discovered that Singapore recognises degrees from 19 English Universities and to be eligible for admission in Singapore, the English qualifications should be at Second Class Upper or better.
