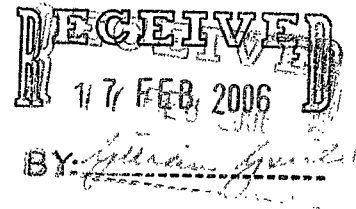


DEAR SIRs.
