It is time for the Australian government and associated industry to take note of the Australian people which is why I am moved to put pen to paper. There are practices in play in Australia that are openly undemocratic. The World Trade Organisation is being supported by the Australian Government when the decisions that are being made are in no way supporting the people it has been elected to represent.
