On neither occasion did I request, intimate or expect such favourable treatment. Whilst appreciated, both seating allocations amounted to an involuntary upgrade.

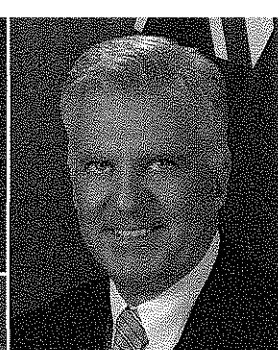

Having stayed two days outside the official delegation, I advise that I personally met all costs associated with the additional accommodation.

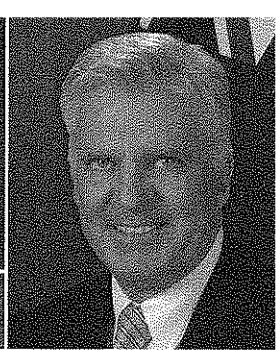
