



Public hearings for the review of Australian Charities and Not For Profits

Commission exposure draft legislation

The House Economics Committee will hold public hearings for its inquiry on Thursday and Friday, 26 and 27 July, in Parliament House in Canberra.

The exposure draft establishes the Commission, requires it to maintain a register of not-for-profit entities, provides powers to the Commissioner to regulate these entities, and details the obligations and responsibilities of registered entities.
